TICKET PRICES:

- GENERAL ADMISSION PRICES range from \$10.00 \$15.00 plus service fee. Day of event prices will be \$20.00 at the door. Additional experiences can be added on to every general admission ticket. General Admission tickets will get each consumer into the exhibitor hall, pavilions, vendors, seminars and concert. Please note: Seminar and Concert Seating is first come, first served.
- □ VIP Experience Packages Begin at \$100.00 includes all day access to the VIP Backstage Lounge
- □ **Group Sales of 15 or more** can receive a 10% discount off of General Admission Tickets. Group Sales Must Be Purchased at the Radio One Business Office. Cash is not accepted.
- □ **Children 12 and under** are free but must be accompanied by an adult. **NO STROLLERS **Proof** of age may be asked at the door**

CONCESSIONS:

- No outside food or drink may be brought into the arena.

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

 - Oversized bags
 - All illegal guns and weapons are prohibited
 - Pepper spray/Mace

- Strollers large strollers are not allowed. If you must bring a stroller, it must be the umbrella type that can fold and stow under your seat
